- 3. Please arrive at the hospital on time and be sure you have someone to drive you home after the procedure. If taking a cab,or the elder bus someone other than the cab driver must accompany you home.
- You may take your regular medication(s) with a sip of water unless otherwise directed by your doctor.
- Stop Aspirin, Aspirincontaining products and antiinflammatory medications for one week prior to your scheduled examination.
 Tylenol is OK anytime.
