

Please follow these instructions for your morning exam:

1. You should have nothing to eat after midnight.
2. You may have clear fluids (i.e; black coffee, black tea, juice, soda, broth, Jell-O) up to 2 hours before your procedure arrival time.
3. Please arrive at the hospital on time and be sure you have someone to drive you home after the procedure. If taking a cab, or the elder bus someone other than the cab driver must accompany you home.
4. You may take your regular medication(s) with a sip of water unless otherwise directed by your doctor.
5. Stop Aspirin, Aspirin-containing products and anti-inflammatory medications for one week prior to your scheduled examination. Tylenol is OK anytime.
